- Maintain strong lines of communication and work in partnership to best meet the needs of our children

- Set high expectations in all areas of school life.
- Provide a broad, balanced and inclusive curriculum which allows every child to flourish and develop

- Providing rich and vibrant learning experiences both in and out of the classroom.

- Issue regular homework to further the work covered in school.
- Be open, welcoming and happy to meet parents at times suitable for all, encouraging you to become
  involved in the life of the school.
- Achieve high standards of behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility.
- Encourage your child to make healthy choices in terms of the food they eat and physical activity they undertake.

### The parent(s)/guardians will do our best to:

- Support the schools' Christian ethos and the Christian values of Love, Respect, Friendship, Truthfulness, Courage, Perseverance.
- Make sure my child attends regularly and provide a written explanation of the absence on the first day of their return.
- Avoid taking term time holidays.
- Make sure my child arrives at school on time, ready to learn, and is collected on time.
- Support the school in maintaining high expectations of behaviour.
- Inform the school if there are circumstances at home which may affect my child's behaviour, wellbeing or work.
- Attend Parents' Evenings to discuss my child's work.
- Read regularly with my child and assist with any other homework.
- Ensure the school has up-to-date information for emergency contacts.
- Ensure my child wears the correct school uniform, has a sensible haircut and brings the correct PE/Outdoor Learning Kit to school.
- Encourage my child to make healthy food and lifestyle choices.
- Follow our healthy schools' policy for breaktimes and lunchtimes and make sure the school drink is water
- Support the activities of the Friends PTA.
- Show consideration to our school community and the safety of all whilst dropping off and picking up my child.
- Read the weekly newsletter to keep up to date with key events and information
- Check my child's bag daily and complete all forms on time to allow my child to participate fully in activities that enrich their curriculum
- Promote a strong and positive relationship with the school, discussing any issues directly avoiding the use of social media.
