

SWITCHING ON SUBTITLES IMPROVES CHILDREN'S READING ABILITY

Switching on subtitles while watching TV shows can significantly enhance children's reading ability, according to research by Access Education. The study found that popular shows like Peppa Pig, Paw Patrol, and Thomas & Friends, when watched with subtitles, improved the reading skills of children aged four to seven. Co-founder of Turn on the Subtitles, Henry Warren, compared it to sneaking vegetables into dinner, stating that children may not notice, but it benefits them greatly. The research also revealed that shows like Peppa Pig, Bing, and Bluey have a high number of "high-frequency words," making them particularly beneficial for children's reading development.
